- 1. **Be a registered full-time student at UCSI University** with a **valid student visa** and **meet the English Requirements** (with a score of Band 6.0 in IELTS or 80 (internet based) in TOEFL or equivalent).
- 2. In the event that an applicant does not fulfill the English requirements, he/she needs to sit for the English Placement Test and undergo the English Enrichment Programme prior to the programme.
- 3. Scholarship applicants for Music programmes are required to meet and satisfy the qualifying criteria set up by the respective school or faculty and must pass an admission interview or entrance audition and placement tests through direct application.
- 4. Complete the UCSI University Trust Scholarship application form obtained either at UCSI University Trust Office, at the UCSI University or downloaded from www.ucsiuniversity.edu.my or www.ucsiuniversitytrust.com
- 5. Furnish true and accurate information, failing which their application will be withdrawn without prior notice.
- 6. Forecast result is accepted for application if the official result has not been released at the point of new intake.
- 7. Submit application form to the UCSI University Trust before the respective submission deadline. (Please refer to the instructions on submission)
- 8. Submit their applications early for prompt approval. Late and incomplete applications will not be considered.
- 9. Produce certified true copies of examination results and other supporting documents stipulated in the form during the interview.
- 10. NOT be bonded to or be a recipient of any financial aid or award/scholarship/bursary from other educational institutions or organisations.

OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. Shortlisted applicants will be notified by the UCSI University Trust via email or sms of the date, time and venue of the scholarship interview to be conducted.
- 2. Successful applicants will be informed by the UCSI University Trust via email within 2 weeks after the interview. They must confirm acceptance of the scholarship within 2 weeks, failing which the scholarship offer will be automatically withdrawn.
- 3. Scholarship /Bursary offered is based on actual results only and will be effected from the date an official offer is made.
- 4. The scholarship/bursary awarded is in the form of **tuition fee waiver** for the programme and duration offered and is neither transferable to another candidate nor exchangeable for cash.
- 5. Successful applicants agree to pay the initial tuition fee stated in the Letter of Acceptance and any miscellaneous and other fees not covered by the scholarship including the cost for English Enrichment Programme.
- 6. Successful applicants have to sign an agreement with the UCSI University Trust and observe the terms and conditions as set therein.
- 7. Successful applicants need to maintain discipline, attendance, high academic and exemplary behaviour throughout their studies at UCSI University.
- 8. Successful applicants are to participate actively in the institution's sports, extracurricular and other relevant activities.
- 9. Successful applicants are to voluntarily contribute effort and time by participating in the Scholar Enrichment Programme and be involved in various workplace and community projects by the UCSI University Trust (100 SEP Points per normal semester or 50 SEP Points per short semester).
- 10. All information provided by the applicants must be true and correct. If inaccurate information is provided, the scholarship will be withdrawn without prior notice.
- 11. Scholarship/Bursary may be terminated at any time in the event of gross misconduct or failure to meet the required academic grades.
